Aspirational	Ambitious, a goal you are aiming for.
Underpin	To support or strengthen something.
Enquiry	The act of asking questions to gain information.
Self-directed	Making your own decisions and managing your own work.
Realisation	The act or moment of achieving something you planned to do.
Critically	To make critical judgments about something.
Sustained	Work created through the process of developing, creating, revising, and exploring the idea of your guiding question.
Fluent	Able to express oneself easily and articulately.
Autonomy	In its simplest sense, autonomy is about a person's ability to act on his or her own values and interests. Taken from ancient Greek, the word means 'self-legislation' or 'self-governance'.
Proactive	Acting in anticipation of future needs, problems, or changes.
Reactive	Responding to a situation or problem.
