Edit	To make changes to.
Conceptual	Ideas are more important than the finished work.
Contextual	Related to or dependent on its context or setting.
Analysis	Detailed examination of the elements or structure of something.
Interpretation	Refer to a particular version or adaptation of a work, style, or method.
Justify	Show or prove to be right or reasonable.
Concept	Meaning.
Focused	Directing a great deal of attention, interest, or activity towards a particular aim.
Informed	Having or based on a lot of knowledge or information.
Moderate	An average in amount, intensity, quality, or degree.
Consistent	Consistent ability is always producing work of a similar standard and ability.
Highly Developed	To become more mature, advanced, or elaborate in the way your work is produced.
Exceptional	Showing an ability to create excellent and extraordinary work. Work would be out of the ordinary and different in its quality.

Monoprint	A unique/one-off print taken from a design.
Typography	The technique of arranging letters and words.

Impasto	Refers to an area of thick paint or texture, in a painting
Chemigram	An experimental piece of art where an image is made by painting with chemicals on light-sensitive paper.
