### Tier 2 Vocabulary

Key Term	Meaning
Stimuli	Various objects and elements present in the visual field that compete for attention and processing in the brain.
Intentions	The deliberate choice to capture a particular moment, emotion, or story.
Manipulation	Controlling someone or something to your advantage. In art could refer to controlling a certain material/medium.
Holistically	In a way that deals with or treats the whole of something or someone and not just a part.
Moderate	Moderate means an average in amount, intensity, quality, or degree.
Consistent	An ability to always produce work of a similar standard and ability.
Highly Developed	To become more mature, advanced, or elaborate in the way your work is produced.
Exceptional	Showing an ability to create excellent and extraordinary work. Work would be out of the ordinary and different in its quality.

### Tier 3 Vocabulary

Portfolio	A body of work, that displays your best artwork, curated and presented in a professional way. It is a visual representation of your skills, style and creative voice.
Personal Response	A type of creative writing where you express your personal opinions, thoughts, and emotions about a topic, text, or experience.
Bounce	The use of a light source like an external flash unit to reflect the appropriate amount of light onto your subject so that your shot appears bright and sharp.
