Aspirational	Ambitious, a goal you are aiming for.
Underpin	To support or strengthen something.
Enquiry	The act of asking questions to gain information.
Self-directed	Making your own decisions and managing your own work.
Realisation	The act or moment of achieving something you planned to do.
Critically	To make careful judgments about something.
Sustained	Work created through the process of developing, creating, revising, and exploring the idea of your guiding question.
Fluent	Able to express oneself easily and articulately.
Autonomy	In its simplest sense, autonomy is about a person's ability to act on his or her own values and interests. Taken from ancient Greek, the word means 'self-legislation' or 'self-governance. '
Proactive	Acting in anticipation of future needs, problems, or changes.

Depth of field	The distance between the nearest and farthest objects in a photo that appear acceptably sharp.
Long exposure	A technique that uses a long-duration shutter speed to capture stationary elements sharply while blurring moving elements.
Double exposure	Combining two different exposures into a single image.
Bokeh	The aesthetic quality of the blur produced in the out-of-focus parts of an image.
Leading lines	Lines within an image that lead the viewer's eye to the subject.
