Key Term	Meaning
Abstract	Existing in thought or as an idea but not having a physical or concrete existence.
Contextual	Depending on or relating to the circumstances that form the setting for an event, statement, or idea.
Analytical	Relating to or using analysis or logical reasoning.
Sustained	Continuing for an extended period or without interruption.
Critical thinking	Exercising careful judgment or judicious evaluations.
Intentions	A thing intended, an aim or plan.
Informed	Having or based on a lot of knowledge or information.
Commission	An instruction, command, or role given to a person or group.
Subjective	Based on or influenced by personal feelings, tastes, or opinions.
Expressive	Conveying thought or feeling.
Synesthesia	When your brain routes sensory information through multiple unrelated senses, causing you to experience more than one sense simultaneously. Some examples include tasting words or linking colours to numbers and letters.

Chemigrams	An experimental piece of art where an image is made by painting with chemicals on light-sensitive paper.
Edition print	An edition is a copy of a work of art made from a master. An edition print is an identical print.
Calico	A type of cotton cloth, typically plain white or unbleached.
Triptych	A set of three associated artistic, literary, or musical works intended to be appreciated together.
