Tier 2 Vocabulary

Key Term	Meaning
Stimuli	Things that inspire or provoke a response, idea or emotion e.g. objects, music, an article or a documentary
Sources	A place, person, or thing from which something <u>originates</u> or can be obtained.
Purposeful	Having a purpose or goal.
Investigation	The act or process of examining.
Proactive	Acting in anticipation of future needs, problems, or changes.
Speculate	To form opinions about a piece of Artwork without having the necessary information or facts; to make informed guesses.
Analysis	Detailed examination of the elements or structure of something.
Sustained	Sustain means to support your initial ideas and keep those ideas going in your work.
Development	Systematically working towards a better artwork: trialling, refining, and exploring compositional devices and techniques.
Refinement	Refining something means you are going to fine tune it, hone it to perfection, and make it more precise.
Self-Reflection	Taking time to think about, evaluate, and give serious thought to your prior work. Having done this, artists should then aim to improve on prior work.

Tier 3 Vocabulary

Portfolio	A body of work, that displays your best work, curated and presented in a professional way. It is a visual representation of your skills, style and creative voice.
Maquette	The small model made for a larger piece of sculpture. This is created to visualise how it might look and to work out approaches and materials for how it might be made.
Ambient Light	The natural light in a scene.
Bounce piece	A bounce piece identifies the most successful elements of previous work and develops these.
