Key Term	Meaning
Civil War	A war between two groups of people in the same country.
Convent	A building where nuns live.
Dissolution	To end or phase out a meeting or assembly such as parliament.
Elizabethan	A period of time when England was ruled by Elizabeth I (1558-1603).
Government	Group of people that run a country.
Monarchy	Rule by one person, a King or Queen.
Monastery	A building where monks live.
Parliament	The meeting of representatives of the people to help run the country.
Protestant	A group of Christian Churches that split from the Catholic Church in the Reformation.
Reformation	A religious political movement in 16 <sup>th</sup> century Europe. It began by reforming the Catholic church and resulted in setting up the Protestant Church.
Renaissance	A rebirth of art and learning in Europe during the 14 <sup>th</sup> to 16 <sup>th</sup> Century.
Roman Catholic	A follower of the Roman Catholic religion. One of the main Christian religions which has as its head the Pope, based in Rome.
Theatre	A building where plays took place.
Treason	A crime against the King, Queen or country.
