Complete a detailed analytical case study of a chosen Hispanic Festival & deliver spoken presentation	
Compare and contrast differing opinions about whether the religious meaning of festivals is being lost and whether they are simply becoming an excuse for partying and excessive behaviour	
Analyse and discuss both sides of the Bullfighting debate and the use of animals in festivals. Begin to apply structures during discussion that enable debate e.g. “entiendo lo que dices...”, No estoy de acuerdo con tu punto de vista”
