Analyse and discuss the reasons for the period of political and civil unrest and increased violence following the death of Franco including the birth of ETA and increased terrorist activity	
Analyse and discuss the events leading up to the first democratic elections in 1977 including the impact of Adolfo Suarez on the transition process	
Analyse and explain the impact of the “Ley de Amnistía” on members of the Franco regime and victims of the civil war & dictatorship	
Analyse and discuss the impact of the constitution of 1978 on civil and political liberties including women’s rights and the Autonomous Communities	
Analyse and explain Franco’s decision to restore the monarchy through the naming of Juan Carlos as his successor before death	
Analyse and explain the events leading up to the failed Military Coup of 1981, the motives of the protagonists and the role of Juan Carlos in supporting the transition to democracy	
Analyse and discuss the social and creative impact of the removal of censorship
