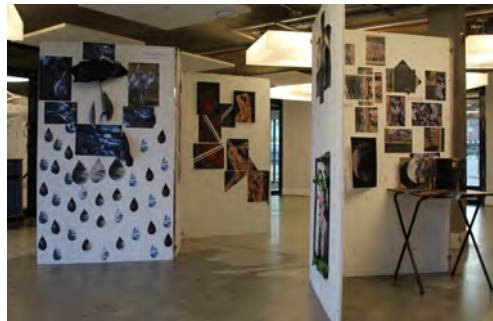
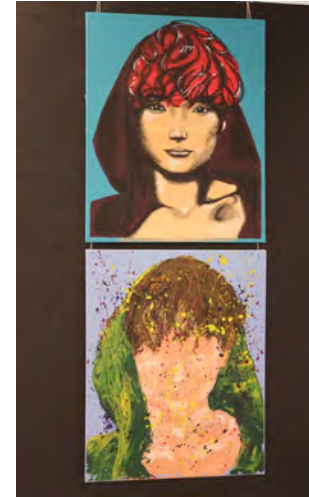

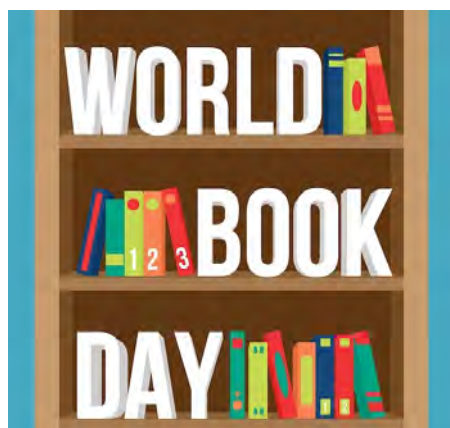
## Year 7, 8 and 9 Musical theatre workshop
