

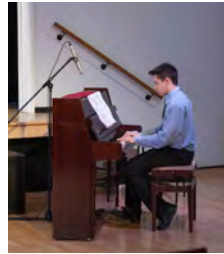


Celebrating Creativity: A recap of the fantastic 'Arts Week' at GHS!

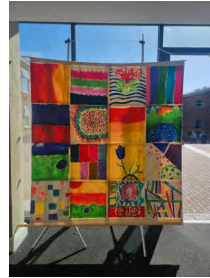

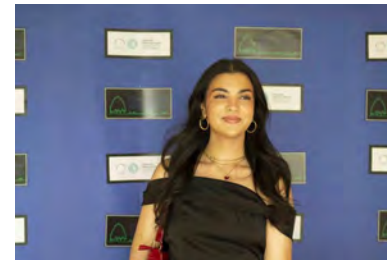

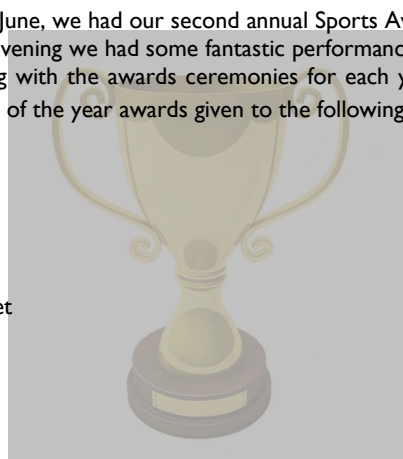

Sports Awards Evening

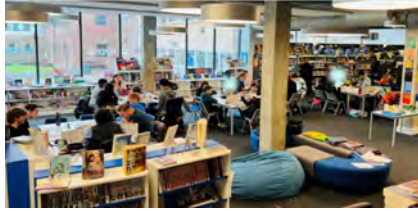

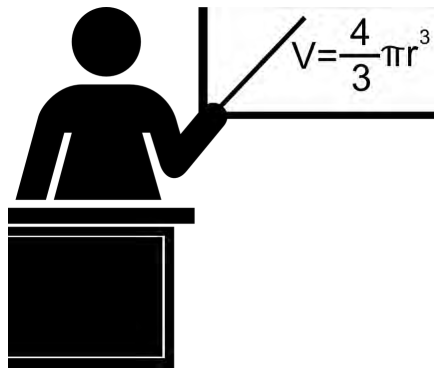
Dungeons and Dragons Festival in the Library

Uniform Update



With warmer weather forecast for the coming weeks we will be moving to our summer uniform.
Summer Uniform Guidelines:

1. Blazers: Pupils are not required to wear blazers or bring them to school.
2. Shirts/Blouses: Pupils may wear for short-sleeved shirts or blouses.
3. Socks: Tights can be replaced by white ankle socks.
4. Skirts: Skirts must be worn at knee length.

In addition to these changes and following consultation with the Governors, the Parents' Council, and the Student Council, we have decided to remove skirts from the school uniform list effective from **September 2025**.

This decision is in response to ongoing issues with pupils not adhering to the school rule of wearing their skirts at knee length. Constant reminders and sanctions related to this matter can lead to negative interactions between staff and pupils. By removing skirts from the uniform, we aim to eliminate this potential area of conflict, fostering a more positive school environment.
