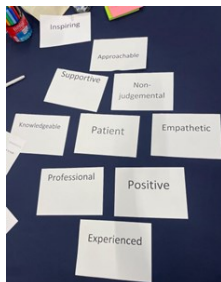
What's coming up



Sutton SCITT Mentor conference 2024

Last week, Glenthorne hosted the first Face-to-Face Sutton SCITT Mentor conference since the pandemic. Sutton SCITT (School Centred Initial Teacher Training) is a partnership of Sutton Schools for initial teacher training whose ethos is to 'grow our own' - local training to support local schools. Established in 2015, the SCITT runs a one year post graduate programme for both primary and secondary teachers and is graded outstanding by Ofsted.

When we consider initial teacher training, we automatically envisage new teachers working with the pupils, setting a positive classroom environment, eager to build relationships, whilst spending time planning lessons behind the scenes. What is often forgotten is the support and guidance they gain from expert colleagues from whom they learn this new trade. Sutton SCITT mentors are a highly valued team of teachers from our partner schools who are pivotal to the success of our trainees. Not only do they work with our trainees on a daily basis, but they also have an opportunity to continue their learning with us. This year, as part of the new reforms in ITE Initial Teacher Education, the SCITT held a successful Mentor conference at Glenthorne High School. Thank you to everyone involved in this event.
