There was a success rate of approximately 9%.

- (i) 57 appeals were lodged parents/carers
- (ii) 2 appeals were cancelled by parents/carers
- (iii) 55 appeals were heard by the Independent Appeal Panel
- (iv) 50 appeals were dismissed (were not successful)
- (v) 5 appeals were upheld (were successful)

## 2023

There was a success rate of approximately 19%.

- (vi) 31 appeals were lodged parents/carers
- (vii) 0 appeals were cancelled by parents/carers
- (viii) 31 appeals were heard by the Independent Appeal Panel
- (ix) 25 appeals were dismissed (were not successful)
- (x) 6 appeals were upheld (were successful)

## 2022
