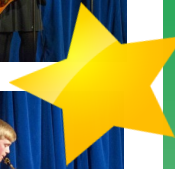

This week a group of Year 10 Health and Social Care pupils were given an exceptional opportunity to visit various aspects of the ambulance service at St George's Hospital to explore Health and Social Care Careers in action. During the visit, pupils were fortunate to be given a guided tour of range of complex equipment inside the ambulances, the emergency control room and the CPR facility. They learned about a range of lifting techniques, saw first-hand the complexities of dispatching ambulances across London and received enhanced CPR training to enable them to perform CPR on both adults and small babies. The pupils were a credit to the school, asking excellent questions and fully engaged throughout.

Thank you to Ms Francis for leading the trip and to Miss Bains and Mrs Dale for providing this unique opportunity.

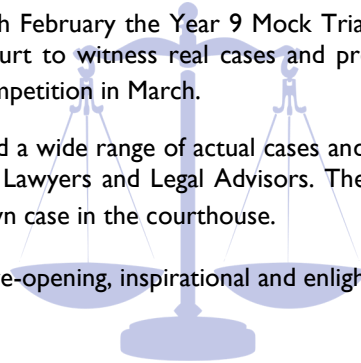


Year 9 Mock Trial


