



## New Memorial Sculpture

Staff, Governors and Trustees gathered in the Courtyard at Glenthorne High School at 4pm on Wednesday 30th April to remember and celebrate Steve Waring's life. Steve Waring was a kind, generous, and dedicated man who gave so much of himself to Glenthorne High School over 36 years, during which he served as governor and Chair of Governors. Over three decades, Steve helped to shape the school into the great place it is today. He played a significant role in the development of many of the buildings, always thinking about how the school could grow and improve for the benefit of its pupils. One of Steve's big ideas, something he talked about for many years, was to create a central hub that would connect all the buildings and become the heart of the school. That dream became a reality in 2020, with the completion of what is now the Hub, a truly outstanding space that connects different parts of the school. It's a lasting reminder of his vision and determination.



Tom Stogdon who has designed and made other sculptures at the school, was commissioned to create the new piece. Trustees wanted the sculpture to reflect Steve's vision of connecting all the buildings through one central hub: an open and welcoming centre that unites the school and allows pupils to circulate naturally between classrooms and communal areas. We also hope that this sculpture will encourage pupils to ask "Who was Steve Waring?", keeping his memory alive for generations to come.

We hope the ceremony demonstrated to his wife, children, and friends how much we appreciated everything he did. His work, his kindness, and his spirit will always be a part of Glenthorne.

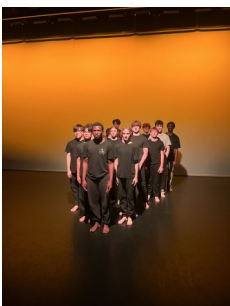
