

# Uniform Update – Effective from Monday, 16th June

Dear Parents and Carers

Due to the weather forecast predicting significantly warmer conditions over the next two weeks, we are making adjustments to ensure pupils remain comfortable during the school day.

From this date, pupils will be permitted to wear either the school summer uniform or the full school PE kit. Please carefully note the following guidance.

## Permitted Options:

### 1. School Summer Uniform:

No requirement to wear a blazer.

Pupils wearing a skirt may choose to wear black tights or white ankle socks. Skirts must be worn with the tree on the knee.

All other standard uniform expectations remain in place.

### 2. Full School PE Kit:

Pupils must wear the complete PE kit as outlined in the school's uniform policy.

### ✗ Not Permitted:

Leggings are not allowed under any circumstances.

Pupils must not mix elements of the PE kit with the school uniform. It must be one or the other.

We appreciate your support in helping us maintain high standards while also prioritising pupil wellbeing during this period of warmer weather. A reminder of the full details for both the summer uniform and PE kit can be found on the school website. If pupils arrive at school wearing incorrect uniform, we will ask parents to bring into school the correct uniform or ask pupils to change into uniform provided by the school. Failure to comply with this request will result in a sanction.

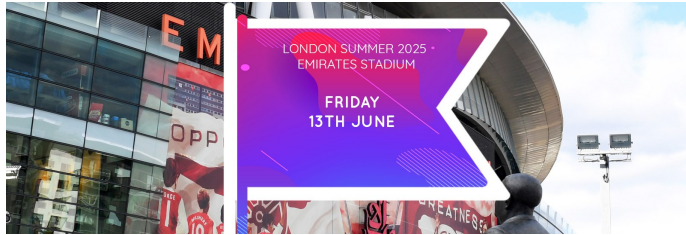

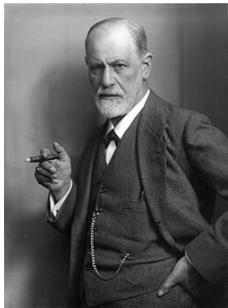
## UK University & Apprenticeship Fair

## Freud Museum



On Thursday 5th June Y12 Psychology students were given the exciting opportunity to attend a live online talk delivered by the Freud Museum. Emilia, who works at the museum and delivered the talk, introduced students to the work of Sigmund Freud and his psychodynamic approach to psychology. Students learnt about Freud's role in the development of talking therapies, as well as drawing parallels between the concepts of the repressed unconscious and the ancient Egyptian practices of burial and mummification. Students also learnt about the role of the unconscious and the personality structure as suggested by Freud, and got to see parts of the Freud Museum where Sigmund Freud practised psychoanalysis and spent his final year here in London. Well done to the Y12 students for attending and participating.

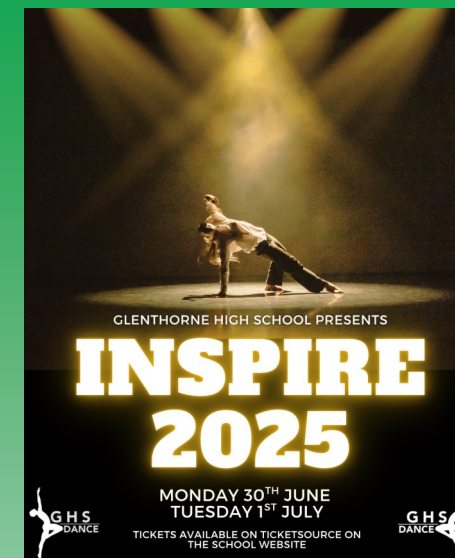
