UK University & Apprenticeship Event



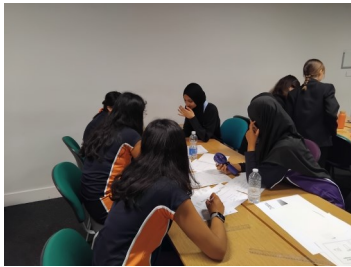

We are excited to share that a group of our pupils recently took part in an inspiring STEM Day on Thursday 19th June, hosted by SheCanEngineer,

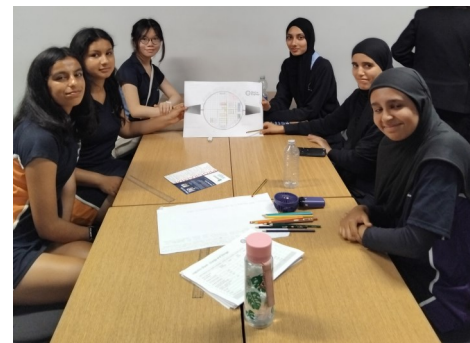
This exciting event, held in the lead-up to International Women in Engineering Day (INWED), was an inspiring opportunity for our pupils to explore the world of engineering and innovation.
