There was a success rate of approximately 7%.

- (i) 34 appeals were lodged parents/carers
- (ii) 4 appeals were cancelled by parents/carers
- (iii) 30 appeals were heard by the Independent Appeal Panel
- (iv) 28 appeals were dismissed (were not successful)
- (v) 2 appeals were upheld (were successful)

## 2024

There was a success rate of approximately 9%.

- (vi) 57 appeals were lodged parents/carers
- (vii) 2 appeals were cancelled by parents/carers
- (viii) 55 appeals were heard by the Independent Appeal Panel
- (ix) 50 appeals were dismissed (were not successful)
- (x) 5 appeals were upheld (were successful)

## 2023
